Bungree Aboriginal Association has been operating as a registered non for profit organisation since 7th July 1995.

We are an Aboriginal community organisation which delivers government funded community based services to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people residing on the Central Coast of NSW.

Bungree is the largest Aboriginal not for profit organisation on the Central Coast and currently employs approximately 35 permanent and casual field employees

We operate and deliver 28 funded programs and services to the Central Coast, Newcastle and Upper Hunter.

Bungree's programs and services target our ageing, children, youth and families, as well as people with a disability and housing needs.

Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP)

Bungree offers a number of services to eligible recipients under the Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP), an initiative of My Aged Care.

The CHSP helps you to stay independent and in your home and community for longer.

Services offered by Bungree under the CHSP include:

- **Flexible Respite**
If you are being looked after by a family member or friend, and need a break from your usual care arrangement, there are services that can help you or your carer to take a break.
- **Podiatry**
Allied health foot care support.
- **Social Support**
Helping you to maintain an active social life by having someone visit you in your home, or by arranging visits and outings in the community.
- **Home Maintenance and Modifications**
Supporting you to stay in your own home by making your home safer and more secure.
- **Personal Care**
Helping you continue living independently including everyday tasks such as bathing and getting dressed.

- **Domestic Assistance**
Including help with housework and practical tasks around the home.
- **Goods and Equipment**
Helping you to maintain your independence if you have a functional limitation or if you just find it difficult to carry out day-to-day living activities.
- **Sector Support Services**
Helping to improve service delivery under the CHSP.
- **Sector Support and Development Officer**
Supporting the implementation of the CHSP, including assisting service providers and clients to move to new arrangements with a focus on consumer choice.
