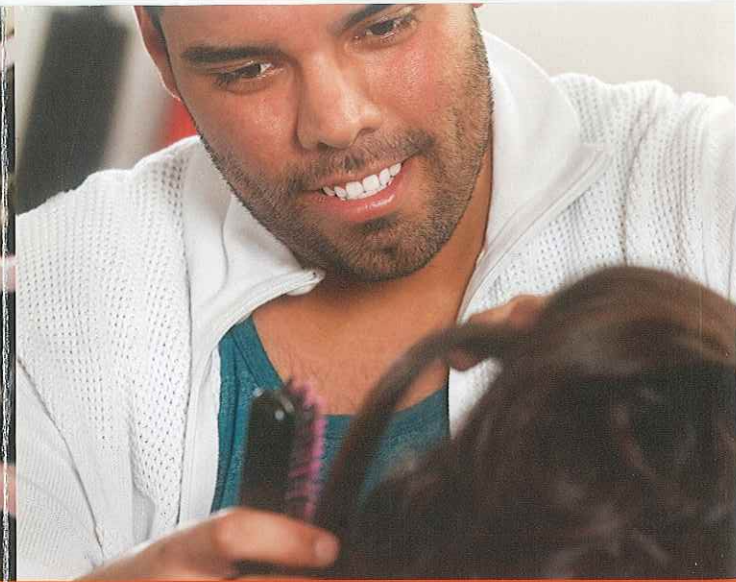

Bungree Transport Services



Our services

Bungree Transport Services is based on the Central Coast and provides transportation assistance for the Aboriginal community in the Gosford and Wyong regions.

Our services are available for the elderly, disabled and frail aged, as well as disadvantaged youth.

There is a range of assessment criteria to gauge eligibility.



How we can help?

Bungree Aboriginal Association provides transport services - for persons who are assessed as eligible - to the following places (including but not limited to):

- Medical appointments - GP, hospital and specialists
- Shopping trips – individual and group
- Community events
- Other community services
- Out of area appointments eg. Sydney and Newcastle
- Hairdressing appointments



Youth assistance

We can also offer transport to disadvantage Aboriginal youth for:

- School attendance – special placements
- Job interviews
- Medical appointments
- Training programs
- School

Bungree can offer community transport to and from any reasonable destination depending on vehicle availability.
