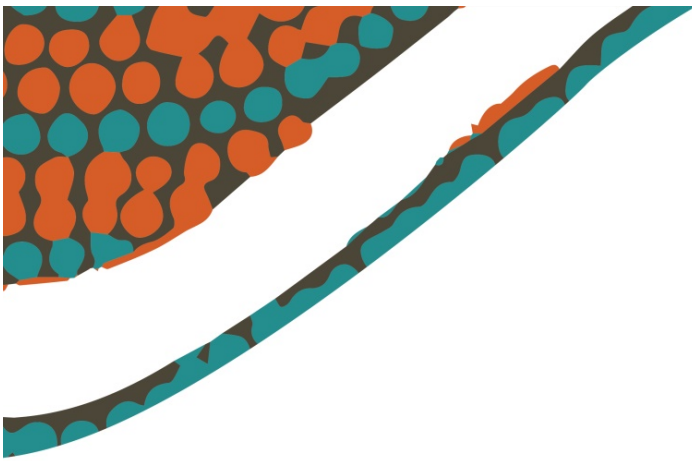

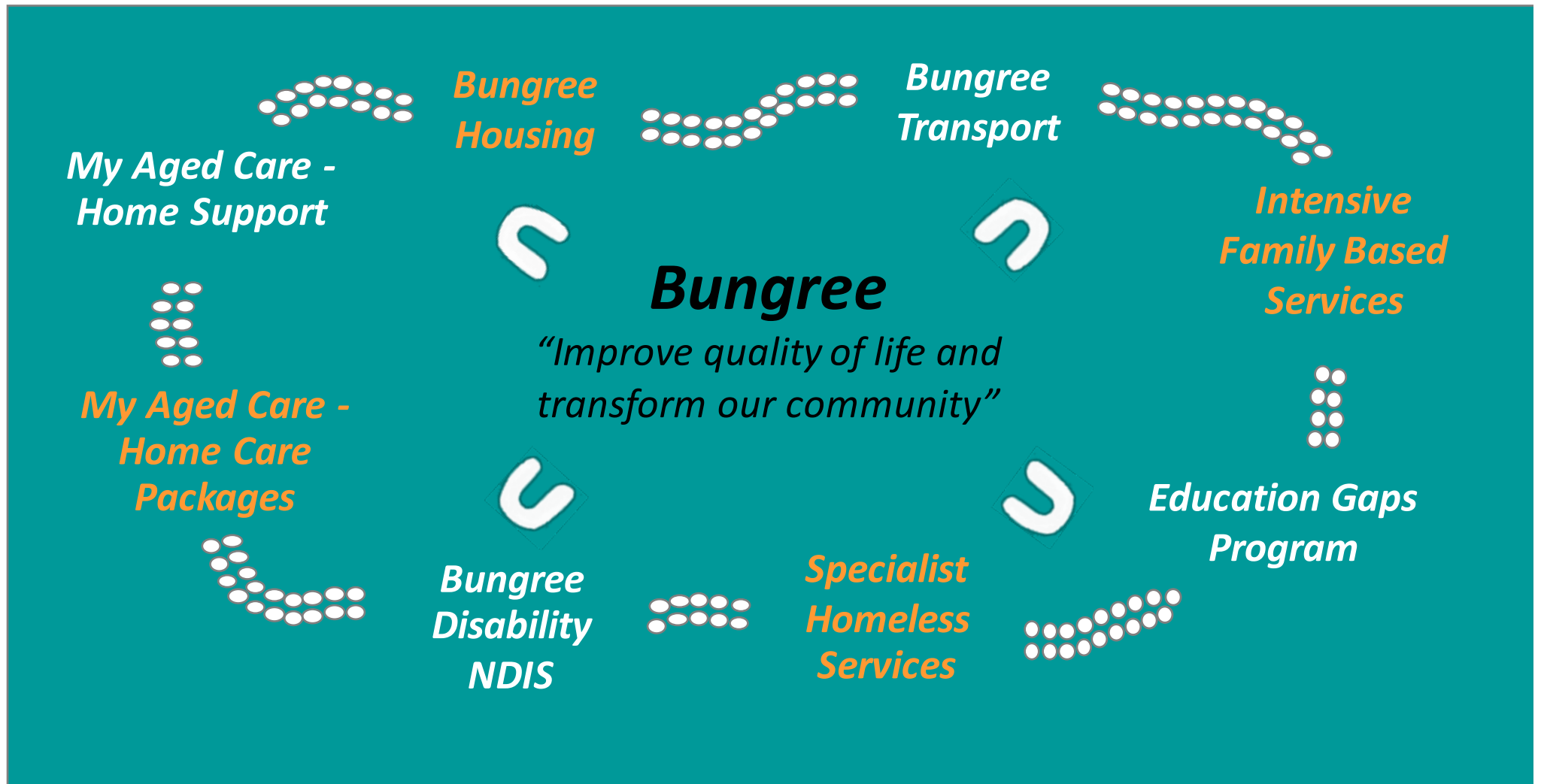
Foreword
